When Tony first told me about it I was thrilled. I, too, play melodeon for Playford dances and the challenge of playing all the tunes in the first edition had always defeated me. When I saw the book and heard the CD I was enthused, delighted and inspired.

To the non aficionado there remains the inherent question - why? Why transpose everything into the limited melodeon keys and why alter the tunes where required. But why not? The melodeon is a most elegant instrument in the right hands and those early tunes can sound bright and wonderful when they are pulled and pushed. From this aficionado a big thank you, Tony. It's a great step forward for mankind - or at least the ones who play melodeon and love the Playford repertoire.
